## Graduation Requirements – 24 Credits

English – 4	Speech - .5

## Course request form instructions

1. Visit Course Selection Forms page of the CAC website (under Secondary Campus tab)

Parents and students will want to give careful consideration to the selection of subjects. The need for teachers, materials, classroom space and textbooks is based on your selections.

It is also important to consider your college and athletic goals when making course selections.

Please note, selecting desired courses does **NOT** guarantee placement in those courses.

**AP/PreAP class** - Instructor approval required for all Pre-A.P. and A.P. courses.

- Expectations exceed standard college preparatory class requirements and require a significant commitment by students
- Grades are weighted
- AP classes require a standardized final exam in May at a cost of (\$93) per exam
- Placement standards:
  - o Previous academic record
  - o Standardized test scores
  - o Demonstrated student motivation
  - o Prior behavior record

## **College concurrent credit classes taken in partnership with the University of Central Arkansas**

College Music Appreciation, College Algebra, College Speech

- Require a GPA of 3.0 or higher, and a composite ACT score of 20 and reading score of 19. (Math classes also require a 19 on math).
- Courses are \$10 per credit hour payable to UCA (they bill you) and \$100 per course payable to CAC
- Textbooks must be purchased
- Grades are not weighted

## **On-Line concurrent credit classes taken in partnership with Pulaski Tech**

- Require a GPA of 3.0 or higher and a composite and reading ACT score of 19. (English classes also require a 19 in English).
- Courses are \$285, payable to PT. If less than 10 students enroll in a class, the cost is \$140 per credit hour plus fees
- Textbooks must be purchased
- Grades are not weighted
